THE AVAILABILITY OF ASSURANCE OF SALVATION	EMPHASIS ON AVAILABILITY OF ASSURANCE AS A MATTER OF REFLECTION UPON A PAST TRACK RECORD OF GOOD DEEDS (FLOWING FROM GOD'S WORK IN THEIR LIVES)	EMPHASIS ON THE AVAILABILITY OF ASSURANCE THE MOMENT A PERSON IS SAVED
THE ROLE OF WORKS IN THE MATTER OF ASSURANCE	PRIMARY	SECONDARY
THE MEANING OF A LACK OF GOOD WORKS IN A CHRISTIAN'S LIFE	FALSE PROFESSION	LOSS OF REWARDS OR A FALSE PROFESSION
APOSTASY	NOT A POSSIBILITY FOR A GENUINE BELIEVER	A POSSIBILITY (AT LEAST INTELLECTUALLY) FOR A GENUINE BELIEVER
IS JESUS LORD?/IS THERE AN EXPERIENCE SUBSEQUENT TO CONVERSION AT WHICH A CHRISTIAN FINALLY SURRENDERS TO THE LORDSHIP OF CHRIST?	YES/NO (it must happen at conversion)	YES/YES (but not necessarily)
